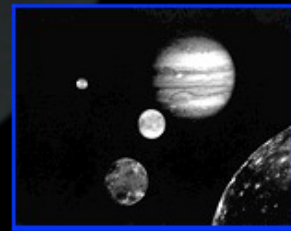
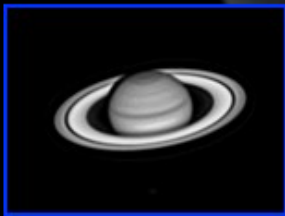
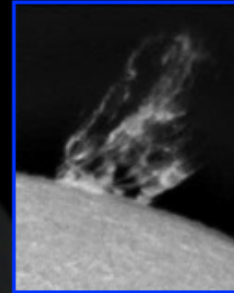


Scopes for Schools
